CODE of CONDUCT for COACHES

- Separate professional behavior from emotional behavior. The number one cause for failure in the organization has been from a lack of professionalism.
- Treat all coaches, umpires, players, parents in this and other organizations with RESPECT.
- Keep your private lives private.
- Be professional with your social media postings. You might consider creating a team page to separate your personal and professional comments.
- Seek help from those that are strong in areas that you are not, ie: accounting/fund raising, coordinating, political issues, event planning.
- Mend broken fences. Problems often occur but few repair the damage after it's done. Show our players how to restore relationships.
- Your parents and players will be as professional as YOU are.
- Be very clear on what all finances cover.
